- **Activity:** Station Open House
Date: October 1, 2010
Participants: Entire Radio Hankook staff
Activity Host: Radio Hankook
Description: Was an open house for listeners and anyone interested in learning more about the radio broadcasting business both on-air and off. Visitors were briefed on the different employment opportunities of the radio business and what skills were needed to pursue a career in this field.

- **Activity:** Paid Internship Program (4 Students)
Date: Ongoing
Host: Radio Hankook, INC / Handong University (S. Korea)
Description: Exchange program designed to assist college students in South Korea, majoring in broadcasting, in acquiring the skills needed to pursue employment in radio broadcasting. Participating students were provided with the opportunity to learn, get hands-on training in many different areas. Total of 10 candidates were screened and evaluated by Radio Hankook and those chosen were given the opportunity to work while learning skills for a term of one year or less. During the period covered by this report, four students participated in the paid internship program.
